REQUIREMENTS

Fabrics from the Autumn 2015 Bumbleberries collection:

- 2m BB40 – Off White
- Fat ¼ each of:
 1. BB41 – Light Linen
 2. BB42 – Vellum
 3. BB43 – Light Grey
 4. BB44 – Grey Skies
 5. BB45 – Aquamarine
 6. BB46 – Light Green
 7. BB47 – Storm
 8. BB48 – Thistle
 9. BB49 – Ink
 10. BB50 – Retro Red
 11. BB51 – Rust
 12. BB52 – Tan
 13. BB53 – Christmas Red
 14. BB54 – Harvest Brown
 15. BB55 – Field
 16. BB56 – Blackberry
 17. BB57 – Dark Berry
 18. BB58 – Brown
- 30cm BB20 – Black
- 54" x 68" Wadding
- 54" x 68" Backing

Use ¼" seam allowance throughout.

Press all seams open unless otherwise noted.

CUTTING

Cut across width of fabric

1. From Storm, Thistle, Ink, Retro Red, Rust, Christmas Red, Blackberry, Dark Berry and Brown each cut:
six, $5\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Cut each square in half diagonally to make total twelve triangles in each fabric.
2. From Light Linen, Grey Skies, Light Green, Harvest Brown and Field each cut:
five, $3\frac{5}{8}$ squares,
one, $5\frac{3}{4}$ " square. Cut square in half along diagonal twice to make four triangles in each fabric. Note you will only need two triangles from each fabric.
3. From Vellum, Light Grey, Aquamarine and Tan each cut:
six, $3\frac{5}{8}$ squares.
4. From Off White cut:
five, $2\frac{1}{4}$ " strips,
six, $2\frac{3}{4}$ " strips,
four, $5\frac{3}{4}$ " strips sub cut into:
twenty seven, $5\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Cut each square in half along diagonal twice to make 108 triangles.
5. From Black cut:
five, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Piecing

1. Quilt is pieced in vertical rows.
2. Join one, $5\frac{3}{4}$ " Off White triangle and one, $5\frac{3}{4}$ " Grey Skies triangle together along one short side to make a pieced triangle. Add one, $5\frac{3}{8}$ " Christmas Red triangle to make a square block.



3. Make a second block in similar manner. These blocks form top and bottom blocks in a vertical row.

4. Join one, $5\frac{3}{4}$ " Off White triangle to opposite sides of one, $3\frac{5}{8}$ " Grey Skies square. Add one, $5\frac{3}{8}$ " Christmas Red triangle to top and bottom of joined units to make a rectangle block.



5. Repeat to make five rectangle blocks.

6. Join rectangle blocks together in a vertical strip and add square blocks to top and bottom to complete row 1.

7. Make rows 3, 5, 7 and 9 in same way with fabric combinations as follows:

row 3 – Field squares and Brown triangles,

row 5 – Harvest Brown squares and Storm triangles,

row 7 – Light Green squares and Thistle triangles,

row 9 – Light Grey squares and Ink triangles.

8. Make six rectangle blocks for rows 2, 4, 6 and 8 in similar manner but note blocks are mirror image blocks. Join rectangle blocks together to make rows.



9. Pair fabrics as follows:
 - row 2 – Vellum squares and Blackberry triangles,
 - row 4 – Aqua squares and Dark Berry triangles,
 - row 6 – Tan squares and Rust triangles,
 - row 8 – Light Linen squares and Retro Red triangles.
10. Join rows together along their length to complete quilt centre.

Assembly

1. Trim two, 2¼" Off White strips to measure 2¼" x 41" and add to top and bottom edges of quilt centre.
2. Join remaining 2¼" Off White strips end to end and sub cut into two, 2¼" x 58" strips. Add to opposite sides.
3. Join 1½" Black strips end to end and sub cut into:
 - two, 1½" x 44½" strips,
 - two, 1½" x 60" strips.
4. Add to quilt in similar manner.
5. Make and add outer border in same way with 2¾" Off White strips sub cut into:
 - two, 2¾" x 46½" strips,
 - two, 2¾" x 64½" strips.

Completion

1. Sandwich quilt top with wadding and backing. Pin or baste layers.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind edges with leftover fabrics.
