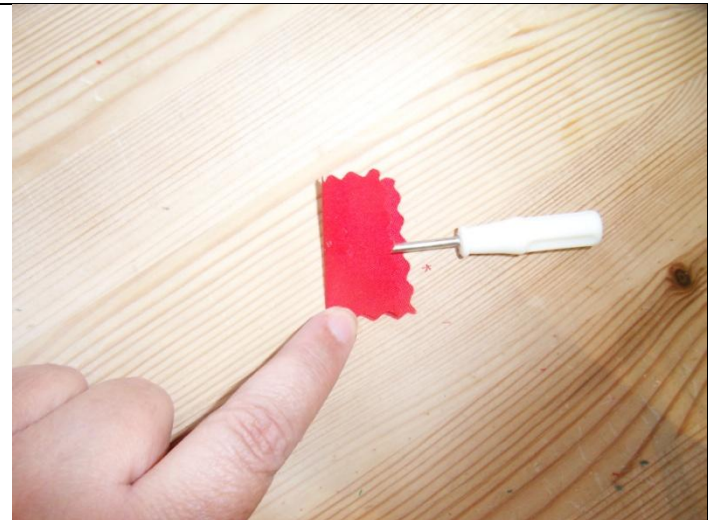
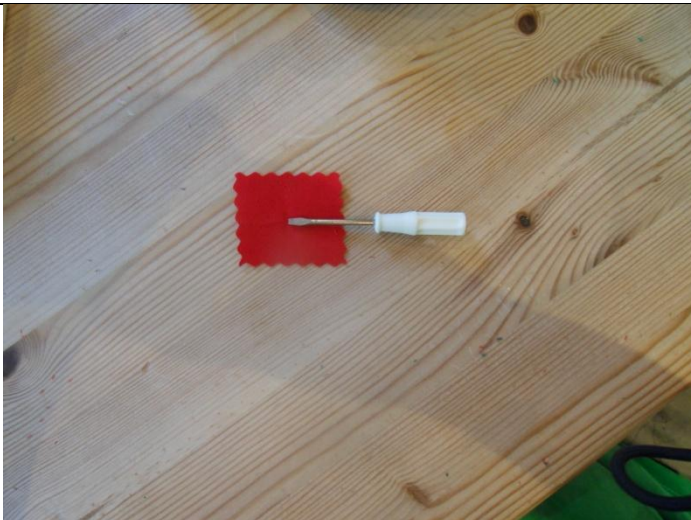


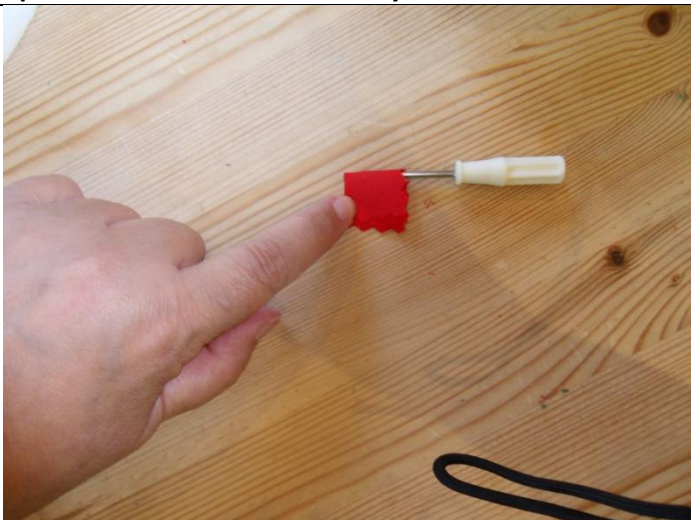
ROSEBUD WREATH

Materials needed: One 25cm (9-10 inch) polystyrene half ring, 3/4 metre of plain medium green fabric, 3/4 metre plain dark green fabric, 1/2 metre plain red fabric, pinking rotary cutter or pinking shears, small screwdriver or stylus, tacky glue, floral pin.



1- Cut all fabrics into 1 1/2" squares using the pinking blade on the rotary cutter or pinking shears. The squares do NOT need to be really accurate.

2- Position tip of small screwdriver at the centre of each fabric square, and fold square in half over the tip.



3- Fold square in quarters, enclosing the tip of the screwdriver.

4- Roll folded fabric square around the tip of the screwdriver.



5- Dip the centre point of the fabric square into tacky glue.

6- Poke the fabric covered screwdriver into the wreath and then twist . Use about 5 to 6 green squares for every red "flower" is completely surrounded by green "leaves". Poke a floral pin dipped in tacky glue into the backside of the wreath to hang.
