

# Flo`s Wild Flowers quilt 1

Block size 12½" x 12½"

## REQUIREMENTS

Fabrics from the Flo's Wild Flowers collection:

1. FLO9.2 - Pink & Yellow Wild Rose -  $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 60cm
2. FLO9.3 - Peach Wild Rose -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{2}$ mtr
3. FLO10.2 - Bluebells on dusky plum -  $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 60cm
4. FLO11.2 - Lily of the Valley on latte -  $\frac{7}{8}$ yd – 80cm
5. FLO12.3 - Daisies on cream -  $\frac{5}{8}$ yd – 60cm
6. FLO12.4 - Daisies on sage green -  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd -  $\frac{1}{2}$ mtr
7. BB40 - Off white -  $\frac{7}{8}$ yd – 80cm

Wadding and backing 64" x 64"

Use  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

13 x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 2 cut

24 x  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 3 cut

13 x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

24 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 5 cut

6 x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)

24 x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 2)

From fabric 6 cut

36 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 7 cut

52 x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)



Block 1

Making up the block

Carefully lay out all of your fabric pieces for each block.

Start by sewing the small triangle pieces to the adjacent larger triangle to form a rectangle, you will to make four of these for each block.

Lay out all of the block pieces and sew them together in rows. Once the rows are complete, sew the rows together to complete the block.

You will need to make 13 of Block 1 in total.



Block 2

Carefully lay out the pieces for each block

Start at the bottom, take one of the small corner triangles and join it to the adjacent square. Next add one of the larger triangles to the opposite side of the square.

Repeat this process with the remaining square, then lay out all of your block pieces again. You will now be ready to join the block pieces together to form a rectangle.

Add strips to either side of the rectangle to complete the block.

You will need to make 12 of Block 2 in total.

Once you have completed making up all of your blocks, lay them all out as shown in the main diagram

Stitch the blocks together in rows, on each row press the seam in the opposite way, doing this will help when sewing the rows together.

Sew the rows together to complete the top layer.

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine.

Add binding made up from fabric 7.
