Disappearing 9 Patch (and other blocks)

Cut 9-patch (or disappearing 9 Patch) is a very popular and easy design but with this setting Valerie has found that the design tessellates so that you get a wonderful zig-zag across your quilt.; no need to add sashing.

The block does come with a warning from Valerie though – it can be addictive. Great for beginners and those wanting to use up their fabric and/or for a quick quilt.

For those wanting something a little more challenging, Valerie will show you another couple of disappearing blocks – Disappearing Hourglass and Disappearing Pinwheel.

Fast Flying Geese - with no waste

Valerie loves this technique as it allows her to make borders really quickly to use either at the edge of a quilt or around a medallion centre, as well as quick quilts (you make 4 geese at a time!) – no triangles to cut and a very economical use of fabric. This is basically a technique class but those wanting to make a quilt could do so (If there are any hand sewers out there, this could be done by hand as well)

Scrap Braids

Scrap braids with or without chimney stones - a really great scrap idea which can be completely random colours or beautifully colour co-ordinated; we can use up scraps and/or jelly rolls – easy sewing so great for beginners or those wanting to use up some of their stash. (this could be sewn by hand too)



Additional Option

Christmas wall hanging with 3 pockets - fabric or small pre-printed panels – could be done on either the Fast Flying Geese Day or the Scrap Braids day – as both these are technique classes and those who are quick will get both done.
