

Daphne's Family Sampler Throw Completion and Layout Guide



Put blocks together as set in layout below to ensure an even distribution of patterns. The cast-off edges should be sewn from both back and front to ensure the Throw is fully reversible – see the sewing up video on Justhands-on.tv

Layout Grid

Note: this layout is different to the picture above, it corresponds to the layout of the throw in the videos.

A1	B2	A4
B4	Heart	B3
A3	B1	A2

Key:

A = Cream B = Blue

1 Cable Back and Front

2 Diamonds

3 Double Cable

4 Alternate 'Bricks' Blocks

Tassels

Once your throw is in one piece make tassels:

Cut a ball of each colour yarn into 11" lengths

Take 3 lengths of colour A, fold in half and loop through outside stitch. Repeat with colour B, looping through 3 stitches later. Continue alternating colours and placing tassels roughly every 3 inches to surround the Throw evenly.
