



Scrap Crumb Block

Requirements

10" Square Ruler

Scraps bags of fabric (a 5' full plastic bag will usually make 2 blocks)

Cutting Mat & Rotary cutter

Suggested Method

Collect together scrap pieces at least 1" wide any length works.

Colour coordinate or coordinate by designer.

Set you sewing machine to a short stitch approx 2.00

Start with a long strip and add pieces onto the strip using a 1/4 inch seam.

Iron and trim between the blocks.



Continue to add scrap pieces to each other trimming and ironing as you go. If the edge gets a bit wonky trim straight so you can add further pieces.

When you get close to 10" measure against your square ruler and add any additional pieces if required.

Trim your finished square to 10" Any fabric left over can go towards another block.

These blocks can then be used wherever the pattern calls for a 10'Square or Layer cake.
